Things needed as we went along.

I am still trying to get sponsorship to fix up and repair the Alma road gate entrance. Another R2000 is needed. It is in a shocking state as an entry to the Park. Many people use this as it is the easiest way to find the Centre off Bowling Ave.

The ICC visited the Centre and came in that way. I was so ashamed to think that was the entrance they used. For 2010 this should be done as Ullman is the closest Park to the CBD being at the extension of Katherine Ave. into Bowling.

Mr. Illing of the Ski boat club paid for compost R300 and fetched it. He also paid for the consultation with a tree expert and paid for the chemical spray for the diseased trees (sooty mould) and for the weed grass to be sprayed.
